Karen was forced to quit her position in the Health Care field to care for them alone because her husband has been stationed in Iraq. Karen deserves a lot of credit for what she has done but her father's death has been a devastating blow. She was very close to him.

The Memorial Service will be held at the Community Center where they live in Leonardtown. It's a long but scenic drive for some. After the Memorial everyone is invited to Jacks' house, which is nearby, for refreshments and fellowship. Karen may have some of Jack's memorabilia on display as well.
