A REPORT FROM OUR

Secretary

n Saturday January 30th Stephenson Lodge had three brothers attend the Grand Lodge Session, which is sort of the State of Masonry in Maryland address. Each committee addressed the assembly of bothers, mostly Worshipful Masters, Grand Inspectors and secretaries, and explained where they currently were and their plans for the near and far future. There's not enough room to go into each address, but the Grand Master gave an overview that was interesting. Here are some of the figures presented at the meeting. As of the end of 2009, we have 16,836 Maryland Master Masons, of which about 10,000 live in the state. By my calculations, that makes about one third of Maryland Masons living in other states and jurisdictions. The largest percentile is the 70 to 79 years age group. This large group of men represents the post World War influx of men joining the fraternity.

In 2009, the Grand Lodge lost about 500 members who passed away during the year. They also lost about 200 members to non-payment of dues. The largest group in this category were members that had been Masons between ten to nineteen years and were in their 40's.



It's interesting to see all of the brothers that became Masons after you. You will recognize many of line officers and active members.




A MESSAGE FROM

In the same period of 2009, the Grand Lodge received 728 petitions of which by the end of the year, only 300 were raised, the rest are still in lower degrees. The largest age group for the new petitions was between 30 to 39 year-olds with the 20-29 year-old almost as large.

The Grand Master plans to implement a new program called **2025** where the goal will be to reach 25,000 Maryland Masons by the year 2025. He hopes to have the Lodges produce at least 1,000 petitions annually. Over the next year he will be revealing his plans and programs to reach this goal. With leadership and proper planning it will be obtainable.
